Radiology Department Overview

The objective of the department is to provide state-of-the-art diagnostic and therapeutic services. The department provides the following services:

The administrative director and section managers collaborate on long-range strategic and operational plans, budgets, priorities for resource allocation, and policies and procedures to ensure consistency with the organization's mission.

Meetings of the radiology management team are held monthly. These sessions are utilized to communicate the hospital information, changes in policy and procedure, and budgetary issues, as well as ongoing managerial development activities.

The management team is ultimately responsible for the operation of the department and for measurement, assessment, and continuous improvement of the department's performance. The team will convey the organization's mission clearly and will support and encourage a sense of teamwork among the staff. The management team is responsible for motivating and developing the staff through coaching, appraising, and open communication.

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
