NOTES: Call the Radiologist to review the images before administering contrast. Make sure that the pre and post axial images are in the same location. Use the small FOV pelvis protocol when a urethral diverticulum or bladder pathology is indicated in the hx., or as directed by the Radiologist.

AX T1 FS PRE and POST: The mask will be acquired first, then the scanner will pause and the green light will appear. After the table is removed from the magnet and then sent back within the magnet, the green light will disappear. Upon returning to the control room, click on prep scan and the green light will reappear. Then start the scan. Send the mask, each phase, and the subtractions for each phase to PACS.
