PURPOSE: To designate an individual to serve as the MR medical director and outline their responsibilities.

POLICY:

1. Dr. Gonzalez-Toledo is the designated MR medical Director. He is responsible for establishing MR safety guidelines and ensuring that they are current.
2. Administrative personnel will ensure that MR safety policies and procedures set forth by the MR Medical Director are implemented and adhered to at all time by all of the site's personnel.
3. Final determination of whether or not to scan any given patient with any given implant, foreign body, etc. is to be made by the Medical director or a level 2 designated attending MR radiologist.

Note: Additional sequences may be requested at the discretion of the Radiologist monitoring the exam.
