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Mammography EXAM STATISTICS

Policy: In order to ensure the quality and accuracy of mammography technical and interpretive skills, a medical outcomes audit will be performed annually as defined by Section 900.12 (f) of the Mammography Quality Standards.

- A. A minimum of the following data will be collected for the medical audit:
 1. Dates of the audit period
 2. Number of screening and diagnostic mammograms
 3. Number of patients recommended for additional follow-up
 4. Number of patients recommended for biopsy or surgical consult
 5. Biopsy results
 6. Tumor staging
 7. True Positive mammograms
 8. False Positives
 9. Positive Predictive value
 10. Screening cancer detection rate
 11. Number of minimal cancers found
 12. Recall Rate
- B. Analysis of the data will be performed by the lead interpreting physician or his/her designee.
- C. Mammography results will be correlated with pathology results
- D. The data will be analyzed for each interpreting physician and collectively for all interpreting physicians at the facility.
- E. Each interpreting physician will be notified of his/her results and the results of the collective audit.

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
