FIRE AND SMOKE CONTAINMENT - MOBILE RADIOGRAPHIC UNITS

Purpose:

To provide procedures to follow in order to minimize risks to patients, visitors and employees should a mobile/portable radiographic unit fire occur.

Policy:

- 1. Turn the unit off.
- 2. Remove the unit from the patient's room if possible.
- 3. Move the unit to an unoccupied room, if possible.
- 4. If you are unable to remove the unit from the patient's room: remove the patient and close the door
- 5. Have someone notify University Police at 5-6165.
- 6. Have someone close the doors to all patients' rooms in the area.
- 7. The mobile unit will not flame up.
- 8. The smoke is usually from the insulation on the wires that are burning off.
- 9. Do not put a wet blanket or throw water on the unit as this may cause electrocution.
