USE OF FLUOROSCOPIC EQUIPMENT

Purpose:

To define the Department of Diagnostic Imaging's policy concerning the use of fluoroscopic equipment by non-physician personnel thereby enhancing the radiation policies and principles of radiation safety.

Policy:

- 1. Radiologic Technologists shall not independently perform diagnostic fluoroscopic procedures for the purpose of interpretive diagnosis. Fluoroscope for diagnosis is performed by a Radiologist or a credentialed physician.
- 2. Licensed Radiologic Technologist trained in radiation safety and the proper use of a fluoroscopic machine may fluoroscope only under the direction of a physician and in his/her presence. The Radiologic Technologist may perform fluoroscopic procedures (under the direction of a physician) for:
 - a. Placement of tubes, catheters, and other items,
 - b. Positioning of tubes, catheters, and other items, as required, except for diagnosis.
 - c. During surgical/interventional procedures.
- 3. Technologist will track the dose in the RIS.
